**Confirmation Ministry Covenant

Confirmation Ministry at Our Redeemer is a time of intentional learning and growing in Christian faith and life in order to prepare a young person to affirm their faith in and commitment to Christ. Preparation for Affirmation of Baptism (Confirmation) takes place through loving relationships, learning opportunities, social and servant events, faithful attendance in worship, intentional participation in a specific type of worship leadership, and engaging conversations with adult mentors. Confirmation ministry is a three year program at Our Redeemer, usually taking place in seventh, eighth and ninth grades. The goal is for each student to be ready to affirm his/her faith during the Affirmation of Baptism service.

I/We understand that the following requirements must be completed over a three year period:

- Fulfillment of all class requirements – attending regularly and attending fellowship/service events throughout the year
- Participation in worship on a regular basis, including turning in no less than 20 Sermon Notes
- Participate in Confirmation Camp (summer after 7th Grade and only required for 7th graders)

I/We understand that participating actively in these additional elements of confirmation ministry will enrich the student’s experience and more fully develop an understanding of what it means to be a disciple of Jesus active in the church and the world.
