Sunday September 24th we will kick off Sunday School and our 3rd grade students will receive their bibles in worship. Join us at 9 AM for worship and Sunday School which is dismissed after the children's message. The kids will head back with the teachers and myself for opening and then head to class. We are excited for another year of hearing stories from the Old and New Testament while playing games, singing songs, and creating! Sunday School is for all kids ages 3-6th grade.
